This program, based out of the BOEC's rustic Miner's cabin, capitalizes on a day and a half of spring skiing with the our Adaptive Ski Program, socializing and lots of fun! A focus on practicing life skills through goal-setting, meal preparation and independent action is experientially woven into the skiing and community living.

## **Who Can Come?**

Teens and young adults ages 16 -21 with developmental disabilities, their friends and family. Stand-up, sit-down, first time skiers and snowboarders welcome! The BOEC reserves the right to screen applicants to ensure the safety & cohesiveness of the group.

## **Included in trip cost:**

Food, lodging, ski passes for 1.5 days, ski/board equipment, transportation during the program, one-on-one ski instruction, and BOEC wilderness staffing 24-hours a day during the program. *Transportation assistance out of greater Denver, to and from Breckenridge, can be arranged via the BOEC for an additional cost of 100.00.*

## **Application Deadline:**

Applications will be accepted until one month prior to course start date. Applicants will be screened for appropriateness by the BOEC upon receipt of a completed application packet and \$50 deposit toward course tuition. Acceptance letters will occur within two weeks of our receipt of an application.
