# CANYONLANDS GREEN RIVER CANOE TRIP

## What is it?

Putting in near Green river, Utah, this float trip will take you approximately 68 miles through dramatic Labyrinth Canyon. This section of the Green River traverses one of the only remaining Navajo sandstone canyons in canyon country. We will travel by canoe, with raft support, paddling and camping on the river in a remote and spectacular desert environment for five days. This trip is a flat-water route, with very few small waves and shallow riffles. The trip itinerary lends itself to ample time for off river pursuits, relaxation in camp or exploring the nuances of gourmet river cookery. Basic canoeing skills and safety, minimum impact canoeing, natural history along with other topics will be covered.

## Who is invited?

This trip is designed for adults, ages 18 and up, with traumatic brain injuries, their families and friends. Open minds and adventurous spirits are encouraged to apply. Those who need personal care must bring their own attendant at a reduced cost.

**Cost:** Please check with BOEC for current program costs, (Scholarship information included in application packet) *Transportation assistance out of greater Denver, to and from Breckenridge, can be arranged via the BOEC for an additional cost of \$100.00. Special arrangements may be made ahead of time to pick up participants in Grand Junction and Green River, UT.*

**Included in Trip Cost:** Food, river gear (including dry bags, canoes, paddles, and life jackets), transportation from the Griffith Lodge to and from Utah, and river guides. Participants are recommended to find lodging the nights prior to and following the course, in Breckenridge, Green River or Grand Junction. If you are unable to meet at the BOEC, contact us to make arrangements so you can be picked up in Green River or Grand Junction. Participants are responsible for bringing all items on the personal gear list.

## Tentative Itinerary:

### Day One

- 8:00 a.m. Meet at BOEC's Griffith Lodge, issue gear, pack van
- 1:00 p.m. Pick up clients staying in Grand Junction
- 5:00 p.m. Travel to put-in site at river, set up camp, introductions

### Days Two - Six

Greet the day, eat breakfast, break down camp, launch, skills clinic and river safety talk. Paddle approximately 12-17 miles each day  
Many options for hiking, swimming, exploring and learning about the area  
Set up camp, dinner, campfire, sleep under a blanket of stars

### Day Seven

- 4:00 p.m. Load up van, drive back to Green River/Grand Junction/BOEC Griffith Lodge  
Course end. Until next year!
